Admission criteria:

- Adults only (18 years of age and older).
- Mental health or substance use disorder requiring intensive structured treatment.
- Be willing to engage in treatment.
- Agree to non-violent, drug free behavior while in treatment.
- Be able to cognitively participate in therapy services

Crosswinds Center

Seneca Health Services, Inc. is proud to announce the opening of Crosswinds Center, a treatment facility serving individuals who require short term intensive behavioral health treatment in order to be maintained in a community based setting.

Crosswinds Center is a voluntary, unlocked facility. The 12 bed

treatment center offers private rooms and baths to patients and is covered 24/7 with nursing staff.

The services are available to patients who need more than is available

through outpatient treatment and might otherwise require an inpatient admission to a psychiatric unit. Average length of stay will be between five (5) to seven (7) days.

Sliding fee scale and/or grant funding available for uninsured.



Detoxification Services

The detoxification treatment will focus on enhancing one's ability to return to a life without drugs or alcohol. The treatment goal is to assist the patient in developing skills necessary to rebuild social, family and occupational relationships.

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) services will be available for alcohol and opiate dependence if recommended by the psychiatrist.

Exclusion criteria include cocaine dependence.

Medical clearance is required for patients who have a BAC above 0.10.



Crisis Stabilization Services

Crosswinds Center is a SMOKE FREE facility.

Smoking cessation products will be offered to patients.

Crisis stabilization services are available to patients who are experiencing acute psychiatric symptoms, require medication adjustments in a protective environment, or need more intensive treatment than is available in outpatient treatment settings.

Exclusion criteria include psychosis

(command hallucinations or inability to consent to voluntary treatment), inability to contract for safety of self or others, Dementia, Autism or medical instability.

Medical clearance is required in case of suspected drug overdose, first psychotic episode or chronic unstable

medical conditions such as diabetes, congestive heart failure or kidney disease.

Referral Information

- Is the patient willing & able to engage in treatment?
- Is the patient willing to commit to safety of self and others?
- Is the patient willing to remain drug/alcohol free during treatment?
- Does the patient have a mental health or substance use disorder that requires intensive treatment?

Prohibited items:

- Razors
- Curling irons
- Drug paraphernalia
- Drugs/Alcohol
- Cash
- Matches/lighters
- Cell phones

Locked boxes are available; however, patients are encouraged to keep valuables and cell phones outside of Crosswinds Center.

All admissions require approval of Seneca Health Services medical professionals.
